Perform tests and maintenance on emergency equipment such as generators and pumps.



Review emergency continuity plans. Update contact information for staff.



Check emergency supplies and equipment in vehicles.



Test emergency warning systems. Consider establishing local emergency alerts that citizens can sign up for via text,



Consider establishing emergency reserves of food, water, and medical supplies for use by staff and volunteers in the case of an emergency.



Review/revise emergency action plans for city staff.

Conduct drills; evaluate and improve plans.
